SAS Rises From the Bay

Work on the new East Span's most iconic element — the 2,047-foot-long Self-Anchored Suspension (SAS) Span with its 525-foot-high tower — continues to surge ahead, with 11 roadway sections in place. The SAS will be unlike any other bridge around the world: the longest self-anchored span with a single tower. When complete, this world-class bridge will be another shining engineering jewel and stunning visual landmark in the San Francisco Bay. Watch for the arrival of the first tower sections this summer.

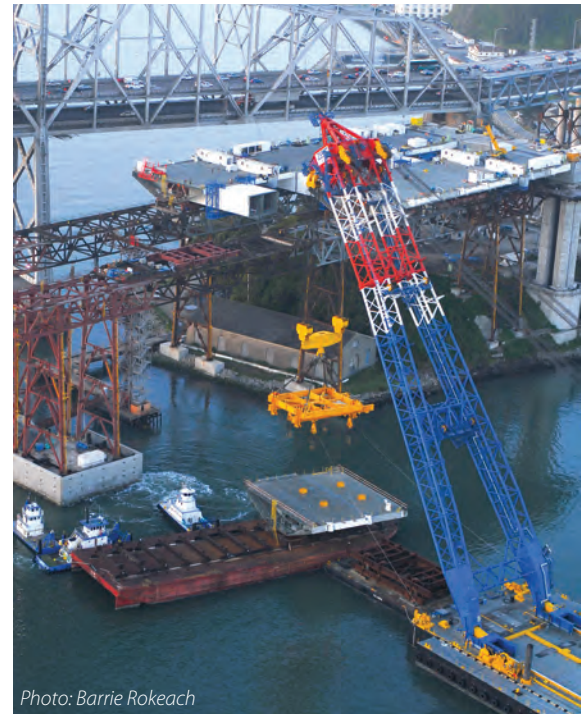
